The New Look and Its Colour

Dear brothers, sisters and friends of Horeb!

Blessed 37th Church Anniversary today! Welcome to our Thanksgiving Service!

You may have noticed a new look to our *Horeb Tidings* this week. Along with a refreshed layout for better readability and focus, we have chosen purple and lilac tones with intentional meaning.

These colours are not only visually calming and match our Church logo, they also carry deep Biblical and theological significance.

In the Bible, purple has long symbolized royalty, holiness and reverence. It was used for the Tabernacle curtains and the robes of the priests (Exodus 26:1, 25:4). Purple was also used for royal robes (Esther 8:15, Daniel 5:29).

In the New Testament purple appears poignantly during Christ's passion when he was clothed in a purple robe as soldiers mocked him (Mark 15:17) - a powerful image of His suffering as the servant-King. In the new Tidings layout different shades of purple help us to focus on King Jesus.

Lilac, a softer hue, adds a sense of gentleness, grace and hope - qualities we long to hold onto in our faith journey.

We pray that these tones invite you to a posture of reverence and expectancy each time we gather, and that the clearer layout helps you follow the important Tidings content each week.

37 years of His goodness.


After the service, do stay for a group photo and some light refreshments

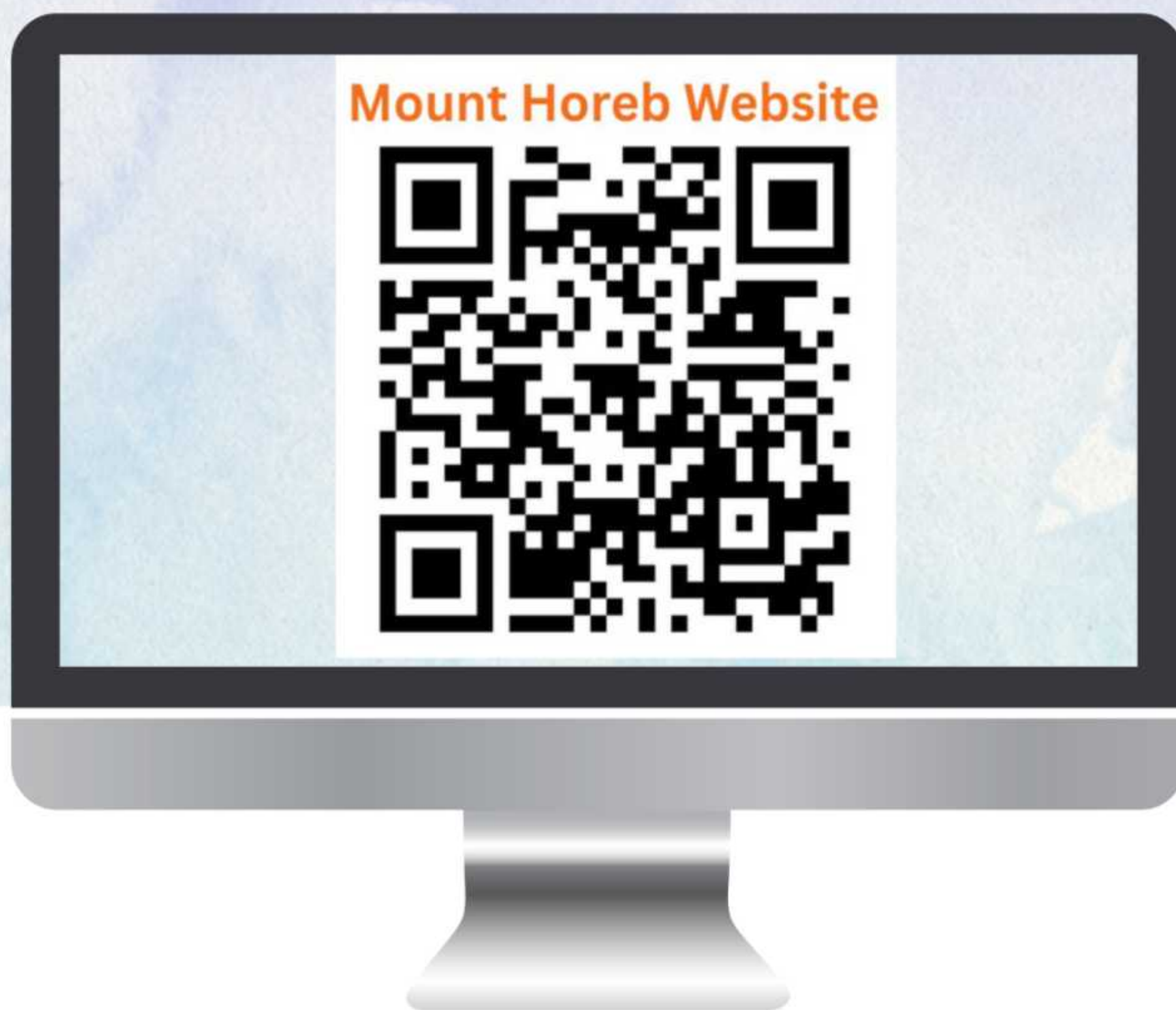
