## Reflections from Our Anniversary Celebration

Last week, we celebrated our 37<sup>th</sup> anniversary and it was great to see so many former Horebians and friends of Horeb in attendance. It is a good reminder of the impact that Horeb, by the grace of God, has had as a church, and that we are not alone in our journey. Indeed, there is much to be grateful for – to Mt Hermon for hosting us here at Henderson, to the wider BPCIS for supporting Horeb in both prayer and deed, and to the numerous former-Horebians for their sacrifices.

When the opening song was sung, the harmony of the chorus of voices, united in the worship of God, was truly moving. It not only reminded us of when we had larger numbers but gave hope that we could be restored to those heights, and even beyond, in God's timing. And so, as we celebrate this year's anniversary, and look forward to more to come, three thoughts come to mind.

The first is that we are **building on the work of the saints that have come before**. Finally, and to tie in to the previous two thoughts, **we need to get very uncomfortable in 2026**. Change will not happen by sitting still, nor will a new generation be raised up. Let us therefore not just be ok with the status quo, nor be lukewarm. May we actively seek the Spirit's help to revive this church – may our young see visions, and our old dream dreams.

And so let us continue to look to the Lord as we continue the Horeb journey, and may He always go before us and lead us on!
