Reflection Questions

1. Does the hope of the resurrection motivate you to abound in the work of God today? If not, why? If so, what are some practical ways you can do so?

2. Describe how the Resurrection of Christ shapes the way you think of life, death and your service of the Gospel.

Experiencing the Joy and Power of Prayer

This week, the Prayer Team gathered to reflect on the beautiful truth that prayer is simply conversation with our personal and loving God. Using the doctrine-of-prayer (*from Bible Study Fellowship notes from the Study of Daniel*), we were reminded that prayer is God's gracious invitation for His children to draw near - to adore Him, give thanks, confess honestly, and bring our petitions with confidence.

We prayed especially that we believers in our Church family will experience the gift of meeting God daily through prayer - not as a duty to perform, but **as a joy to receive**. A prayerless life often leaves the heart weary and spiritually dry. But **a life rooted in prayer opens our eyes to God's presence, strengthens our hope, and tunes our hearts to His gentle guidance.**

We also thanked God for His tender loving care over the parents of several Horebians who recently underwent medical treatments. We prayed that in this season of need, their hearts may **personally encounter God's nearness, comfort, and saving grace.**

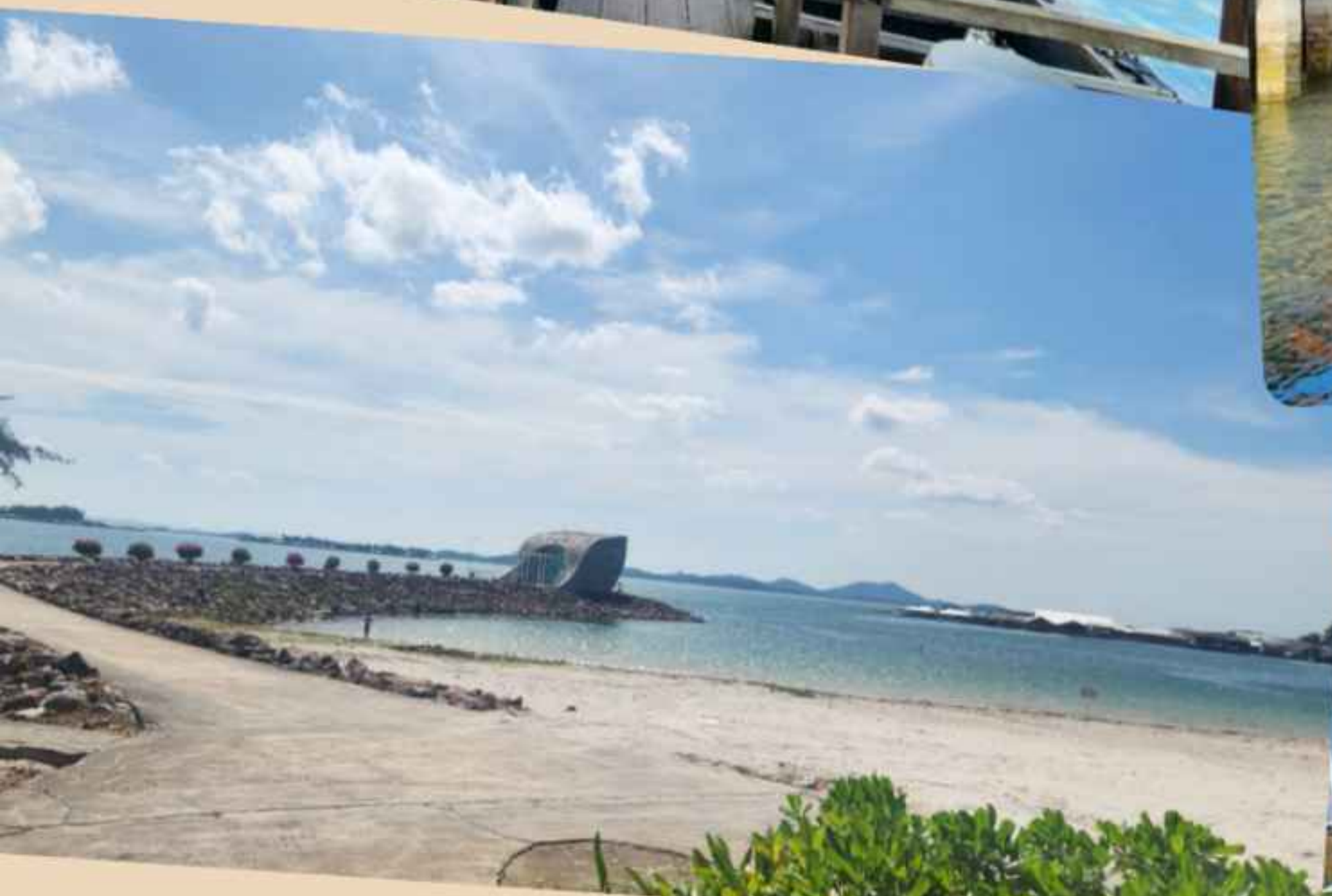
Just as Daniel in the Old Testament experienced God's power in every circumstance, may we in Horeb too **rediscover the privilege of prayer** - where we meet a God who listens, answers, and walks with His people.
